In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity to issue notice to private respondents No. 7 and 8 at this stage.

The petitioner has submitted a representation dated 23.01.2018 (Annexure P-9) to respondent No. 2.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No. 2 to decide the said representation (Annexure P-9) and take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Respondent No. 2 would also be competent to get the said representation decided through any of his subordinate.
