AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of regular bail. Petitioner was arrested in this case on 31.05.2017 as he was found in possession of one country-made pistol along with two live cartridges. Apart from the present case, there were other cases registered against him, out of which, in two cases, he has been convicted, in one of which, he has been sentenced to the period already undergone by him, whereas, in the another case, he has completed the same. Yet in another two cases, he has been granted bail and therefore, he contends that this is the only case in which he is in custody.

Counsel for the State, on the other hand, contends that the trial is now going on and out of total eight prosecution witnesses, two have been examined and the case is now fixed before the trial Court on 18.01.2018.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances of the present case, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.

The present petition is disposed of with above observation.
