Petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.67 dated 18.6.2017 registered at Police Station GRP Hisar, District Hisar under Sections 147, 149, 302, 201 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner places reliance upon order dated 12.1.2018 whereby identically placed co-accused had been granted concession of regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the fact that the petitioner is identically placed as the co-accused, who has been granted concession of regular bail.

In view of the above, on the basis of parity, the petitioner is entitled to grant of regular bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing of bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
