The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.106 dated 18.11.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 452 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code and 25 and 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, District Batala.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on file MLR of the petitioner which shows that he has suffered injuries on the same day and a criminal complaint has also been filed by Jasmit Singh.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Palwinder

Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 16.2.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
