It is contended that petitioner No.2 – Jeetender Jeet Singh, aged about 29 years has got married with petitioner No.1- Amanpreet Kaur, aged about 24 years, against the wishes of his mother, arrayed as private respondent No. 4, who is threatening to interfere in their marital life, as such to seek protection in that regard, the petitioners have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar, to look into the grievances of the petitioners and to take necessary measures to ensure that lives and liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardized at

the hands of respondent No. 4 or persons claiming under her.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
