Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.297 dated 28.05.2016 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 09.03.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
