The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.790 dated 19.11.2017 for offences under Section 13(2), 17 of The Haryana Gaurav Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act 2015 registered with Police Station Nuh, District Mewat, Haryana.

The allegations in the nut-shell are that on receipt of secret information, barricading was raised and vehicle i.e. Bolero bearing registration No. HR-99-TC-0591 was signalled to stop but the driver tried to speed away but since thorn wires had been spread, the tyres of the vehicle were got punctured and the said vehicle was chased for a little

while but the occupants of the said vehicle after abandoning the vehicle fled from the spot. The secret informer identified the person who had alighted from the driver seat as 'Rahul' and the person who alighted from the passenger seat as 'Tarif', but none of the said were arrested at the spot. The Bolero vehicle was found to be carrying five cows and one bull.

Notice of the petition was issued to the State.

The petitioner had been granted interim bail and had been directed to join investigation. Though the petitioner is stated to have joined the investigation but the learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is not cooperating with the investigation and in fact he is wanted in other identical cases and had also been declared proclaimed offender in another case.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the vehicles as well as animals in question have been recovered, I do not find that it is a case of custodial interrogation. Accordingly the instant petition stands accepted subject to the condition that he surrenders before the Court in case in which he is stated to have been declared a proclaimed offender within two weeks from today.

The petitioner shall however, make himself available as and when directed by the Investigating Officer and would fully cooperate with the investigation.
