Learned counsel for the two petitioners in these petitions points to the testimony of complainant, Surinder Nanda, to submit that an unidentified person with a muffled face had snatched the handbag of his wife, containing Rs.9000/- in cash and keys of his house, but he cannot identify either of the petitioners to be that person.

That being so and as per the custody certificates of the petitioners produced in Court today by learned State counsel they already

having put in 5 months and 2 days of actual custody, with no other criminal case seen to be registered against them, without making any comment on the merits of the case for or against the petitioners at this stage, I consider it appropriate to admit them to bail upon them furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
