This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0101 dated 23.07.2017, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Morinda, District Roopnagar.

Counsel for the petitioner prays for grant of regular bail to the petitioner by contending that he has falsely been implicated in this case.

Per contra, counsel for the respondent-State as well as complainant submit that out of total 16 witnesses, 10 have been examined and 05 have been given up. The cross-examination of the Investigating Officer has to be concluded and the case is now listed for 01.05.2018.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that the trial is almost complete, no ground is made out to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

Therefore, the present petition is dismissed.
