The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.0505 dated 10.06.2017 under Sections 406/420 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurgaon, District Gurugram (Annexure P-1), along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise/affidavit (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a monetary dispute between the parties, which has now been resolved. The matter has been compromised.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 21.02.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to

veracity of the compromise. The Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurugram, has sent a report dated 08.03.2018, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a monetary dispute between the parties, which has now been resolved.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" **2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.0505 dated 10.06.2017 under Sections 406/420 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurgaon, District Gurugram, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
