The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of a direction to the official respondent No. 2 to enquire into the matter and take appropriate action in accordance with law on the detailed representation dated 30.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) and reminder dated 11.04.2017 (Annexure P-5) served upon the respondents as till date no action has been taken by respondent No.2 on the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if respondent No.2 be directed to look into the representation dated 30.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) and reminder dated 11.04.2017 (Annexure P-5) and take action in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr.A.S. Sandhu, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in the

Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Three copies of the petition be

handed over to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day failing which no action is called for. He submits that representation dated 30.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) and reminder dated 11.04.2017 (Annexure P-5) will be decided within a period of four weeks.

Without going into the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide representation dated 30.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) and reminder dated 11.04.2017 (Annexure P-5), within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order and take necessary action in accordance with law.
