This order shall dispose of instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.100, dated 19.05.2017, under Sections 13(1) (C), 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and Section 409 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Briefly it may be noticed that FIR came to be registered on the basis of a complaint filed in Police Station Raman on the allegations that during checking of Malkhana, case property pertaining to FIR No. 122 dated 2.9.2015 under Section 7(1) Essential Commodities Act 1955, Section 13/18/21B of Insecticides Act, 1968, Section 420/186 IPC and under the provisions of Fertilizer Control Act at Police Station Raman was found to be missing.

Present petitioner is sought to be implicated on the basis that he was serving Moharar Head Constable in the concerned police station.

Petitioner was arrested on 13.10.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete, challan has been presented.

Trial would take time to conclude.

Co-accused Gursheer Singh, Inspector and Manpreet Singh Constable have been granted concession of pre-arrest bail by this Court.

Without making any observation on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/duty Magistrate, concerned.

Disposed of.
