The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.92 dated 30.10.2017 registered under Sections 419, 420, 468, 471, 170, 467 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Cantt Jalandhar, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 30.10.2017 and his co-accused, namely, Ravinder Singh @ Ravi and Ravi Shanker Tiwari have already been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court vide order dated 17.01.2018 in CRM-M-1005 of 2018 and 05.02.2018 in CRM-M-1880 of 2018 respectively and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petition behind the bars. It is further contended that the charges in this case have already been framed by learned trial Court and there are total 25 PW's but none of them has been examined.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper book.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 30.10.2017, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars any more. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Varinder Singh @ Vicky @ Lalu be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
