The petitioner seeks direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 and 5 in accordance with law.

Notice of motion. Mr. Amandeep Singh Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondents No.4 and 5, at this stage.

The allegations of the petitioner are that respondent No.4 and 5 have allegedly defrauded him. A representation dated 17.05.2017 (Annexure P-9) has been submitted to respondent No.2 in this regard, but no action is being taken thereupon.

The petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2 that enquire into the representation (Annexure P-9) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law, in case a cognizable offence is made out.
