RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.254 dated 31.12.2016 under Section 21 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been wrongly involved in the present case. Nothing has been recovered from the petitioner. The alleged recovery of 2 kg heroin is a planted one. It is further contended that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 31.12.2016.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has submitted that the recovery in this case is heavy recovery of 2 kgs of heroin. It is further submitted that out of 18 prosecution witnesses, only 11 witnesses have been examined by the prosecution. The next date is fixed before the trial Court is 17.08.2018. The prosecution is likely to be completed itself on the next date because only official witnesses are left to be examined.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is dismissed.
