JAISHREE THAKUR, J.

This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No. 262 dated 22.3.2017 under Sections 467, 468, 471, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that during the pendency of the present petition, the matter has been compromised between the parties, namely Sonia and Pramod. It has been agreed between the parties that all inter-se disputes between the parties launched against each other would be withdrawn or statement would be made that they have no objection in case the proceedings are quashed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the respondent—State submits

that after investigation in the present FIR, the police has filed a cancellation report, in which notice has already been issued to the complainant—Pramod.

Learned counsel appearing for the husband—respondent No.3 submits that though they have filed a protest petition against cancellation report, but now the same shall be withdrawn in view of the the compromise having been arrived at between the parties.

In view of the fact that a protest petition has already been filed, let a statement be made before the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate, that the complainant has no objection in case the cancellation report is accepted.

In view of the above, no furthers are called for in this petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
