This revision petition has been preferred by the petitioner challenging the judgment dated 25.10.2016 passed by the Appellate Court, whereby his appeal challenging the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 13.07.2016 passed by the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Palwal, stands dismissed.

Counsel for the petitioner states that in the present case, petitioner has been convicted and sentenced for a period of 6 months. Similarly, in another case i.e. FIR No. 68 dated 15.02.2014 registered under Sections 380 and 454 IPC at Police Station Camp Palwal, for a period of two years. He contends that the petitioner is not challenging the order of conviction and sentence, as has been passed, but is pressing his plea in the form of an application under Section 427 Cr. P.C. read with Section 482 Cr. P.C. for direction for the sentences to run concurrently in both the cases.

Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner, the prayer, as made by the counsel for the petitioner, is accepted. Let the sentences of the two cases run concurrently. If the petitioner is not required in any other case and has completed his sentence, he be released after completion of his sentence.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
