The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.37 dated 18.05.2017, under Sections 406, 498-A, 420, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women, Chandigarh.

By an order dated 19.03.2018 passed by this court, arrest of the petitioners was stayed, in order to enable them to join the process of amicable settlement.

It is submitted that the matter stands compromised between the parties and pursuant to the compromise arrived at between the parties, a

petition for quashing of the aforesaid FIR having CRM-M-12975 of 2018 has already been filed, which fact is not denied by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant/respondent No.2.

In view of the facts that the matter stands compromised between the parties and pursuant thereto, a petition for quashing of the present FIR has already been filed, the petition is allowed and order dated 19.03.2018 granting interim relief to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
