Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.08 dated 04.01.2018, registered under Sections 379, 411 IPC (Section 137 of Electricity Act added later on) at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Petitioner was arrested from a truck containing 70 high tension electricity wires allegedly stolen by co-accused Zuber. Petitioner was employed by Zuber for the purpose of selling these wires in Delhi and in lieu of that, he was given an amount of Rs.800/-.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI

Bachchu Singh states that allegations against the petitioner are that he did reki of the place where these wires were stored. Recovery has already been effected and the petitioner is in judicial custody.

Since, the offence is under Section 379/411 IPC and Section 137 of the Electricity Act, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
