This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.34, dated 03.05.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 326, 347, 427, 452, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Buria.

On 28.02.2018, the following order was passed:-

“During the course of arguments today, it has gone uncontroverted that as against the alleged occurrence dated 19.01.2017, FIR No.23 dated 07.03.2017 had been got lodged against the complainant party and the instant FIR in which the present petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail had been registered only in pursuance to a complaint having been lodged on 29.03.2017. Furthermore, it is a case of version and cross version. Sumit Kumar complainant in the instant FIR had got himself medically examined on the following day of the occurrence i.e. 19.01.2017 whereas the petitioner herein who is also stated to have suffered injuries was medically examined on 19.01.2017 itself.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear

before Investigating Officer and to join investigation. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2)Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar informs the Court that petitioner has since joined investigation.

That apart the observation made by this Court in the order dated 28.02.2018 have gone unrebutted.

In view of the above, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted.

Order dated 28.02.2018 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of.
