Petitioner seeks concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.252, dated 24.11.2013, under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Mattaur, District SAS Nagar Mohali.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he has duped the complainant of a sum of Rs.4.60 lakhs approximately on the pretext of sending the complainant to Singapore on 'S-Pass'.

As per complainant's version, a sum of Rs.3,60,000/- had been deposited in the account of the accused/petitioner. Such factual premise is not disputed by the counsel.

Allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature. The matter certainly requires a deep and thorough probe.

Confronted with such a situation where this Court was not inclined to intervene, counsel prays for withdrawal of the instant

petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
