Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is, time and again, being harassed by the police authorities at the behest of respondents No. 5 and 6, who are filing false complaints against the petitioner. Counsel further contends that the petitioner has no objection in joining the enquiry or participating in the proceedings, if any, provided the petitioner is given proper notice under Section 160 Cr. P.C., which process needs to be followed by the official respondents rather the petitioner is being harassed and pressurized as and when he is called by respondent No. 3 to the police station.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner, in case the petitioner is required for any enquiry, he shall be

given notice under Section 160 Cr. P.C. by the official respondents especially respondents No. 3 and 4.
