As per report received from the Mediation Centre, the matter has been settled between the parties. Settlement/compromise in writing has been forwarded to this Court.

It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioners that under the compromise respondent-Raj Kumar has paid a sum of Rs.1 lac to the petitioners and a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act for grant of divorce by mutual consent has been filed, wherein the statements of the petitioners have been recorded on first motion and now the case is fixed for recording their statements on second motion on 15.03.2019.

In view of this settlement, the present petition does not survive and is dismissed as compromised with the observations that the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement arrived at between them through mediation.
