Petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in a case registered under Sections 307, 326, 379-B, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station, Haibowal, District, Ludhiana vide FIR No. 126 dated 9.8.2017.

On 22.2.2018 when the case came up for hearing, counsel for the petitioner sought withdrawal of petition qua petitioner No.1-Jaswant Singh with liberty to surrender before the investigating agency. Thereafter, he moved another petition i.e CRM-M-8784 of 2018 seeking anticipatory bail. Same was dismissed with Rs.30,000/- as costs. As regards petitioner No.2, learned State counsel at the outset submits that though he appeared before the investigating officer, he has continued to threaten the complainant. Besides, injuries caused in the incident are serious in nature. Admittedly, both the petitioners are brothers. Allegation is that they assaulted the complainant and inflicted number of injuries.

One of such injuries on the head was declared grievous attracting offence

under Section 307 IPC.

Keeping in view the nature of allegations and conduct of the accused, this court is of the firm view that they are not entitled to the discretionary relief of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
