Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.194 dated 25.08.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 188, 427, 436, 120-B 153-A, 124-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Varinder Kumar. Allegations are against a number of assailants out of which two were identified and who after pronouncement of the verdict against Guru Gurmit Ram Rahim had caused damage to diesel vending machines in the Reliance petrol pump being run by the complainant.

The present petitioner was not identified by the complainant. He is sought to be implicated on the statement of a co-accused.

As per prosecution version, a car in the ownership of the petitioner has been recovered and which is alleged to have been used in the occurrence to perpetrate the offence.

Petitioner was arrested on 30.08.2017.

Investigation in the case qua the petitioner having been completed, challan against him has been presented.

The trial is at the initial stage and as such would take time to conclude.

In the totality of the circumstances and without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Kaithal.
