This is a criminal revision that has been filed by the petitioner-husband against the order dated 12.12.2014 passed by the District Judge, Family Court, Faridabad, granting interim maintenance @ Rs.5000/- per month each to the children/respondents No.2 and 3 herein in a petition filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that the instant criminal revision, challenging the order granting interim maintenance, has been rendered infructuous, since the main petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. itself stands decided, which fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for.
