Pursuant to the order dated 19.02.2018, a reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Radhey Shyam, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Mujessar, Faridabad (respondent no. 9), has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel, in which it is stated that respondents no. 4 to 8, of whom respondent no. 4 and 5 are the parents of petitioner no. 1, have stated before the police that they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners with each other.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, A.A.G., Punjab, on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh, submits that as per the statements made by the petitioners themselves before the police of Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur, they are no longer under any threat from the aforesaid respondents.

Hence, though learned counsel appearing for the petitioners has sought an adjournment, I see no reason to keep this petition pending, which is

disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but still with a direction to respondents no. 1 to 3 as also respondent no. 9, to continue to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is duly protected, as per law.
