AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 7 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 16.02.2018 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana-respondent No.2. and Station House Officer, Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana-respondent No.3.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3, to look into the representation dated 16.02.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana-respondent No.2 and Station House Officer, Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana-respondent No.3, to look into the representation dated 16.02.2018 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
