Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.366 dated 29.12.2016 registered under Sections 307/379-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms act at Police Station Sadar Panipat.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he along with co-accused entered the shop of the complainant and pointed out a pistol towards the complainant. They forcibly took away the mobile, laptop and currency notes of Rs.500/- in the denomination of Rs.100/- each. Co-accused Rohit has already been granted regular bail on 03.11.2017 by the High Court in

CRM-M No37670 of 2017.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Parminder Singh stated that Said Rohit was also accused in FIR No.708 dated 30.12.2016 registered under Section 392 IPC of District Karnal in which he was on bail. Petitioner was also involved in the aforesaid FIR i.e. FIR No.708 dated 30.12.2016 and he is also on bail in the said case.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the merits of the case and while treating the case of the petitioner for grant of regular bail on parity with Rohit, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate Panipat.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
