The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.117 dated 12.06.2015, registered under Sections 457, 397, 412, 120-B IPC (Sections 342, 380, 397, 457, 412, 120-B IPC added later) (Challan presented under Sections 380, 342, 397, 452, 412, 120-B IPC), at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.

Earlier the petitioner was on bail and he was absented on 12.01.2016, therefore, his bail bonds/surety bonds were cancelled. He was arrested by the police on 03.11.2016 and since then he is in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana, subject to

following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
