The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.604 dated 18th July, 2017, registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 15th December, 2017.
3. Investigation already completed and challan submitted.
4. The allegations imputed to the present petitioner are virtually identical to those in case of co-accused Sanjay Kumar,

who has already been released on anticipatory bail.

5. Considering the long detention undergone by the present petitioner namely Jai Bhagwan, he may also be now released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
