Pursuant to order dated 04.05.2018, made by this Court, the contemner, who was earlier practicing as an Advocate, appeared before this Court in person today.

We have gone through the reference made for taking action for contempt against him. Upon perusal thereof, we asked the contemner-Ali Mohammad, Advocate, District Courts, Palwal with the assistance of Mr. Chetan Mittal, Senior Advocate, who is present in the Court in some other case, as to whether he would like to tender apology. He submits that he is aged about 63 years and would tender unconditional apology. He accordingly submits his unconditional apology in the open Court.

We, therefore, think that there is no point to proceed further with the present contempt petition particularly in view of unconditional apology tendered by contemner that he would take care and would not repeat such type of acts in future. The unconditional apology tendered by contemner in the open

Court is accepted and the present contempt petition is disposed of. Contempt proceedings against contemner-Ali Mohammad, Advocate are dropped and bail bonds furnished on his behalf stand discharged.
