Pursuant to order dated 23.05.2018, he has appeared before
the District and Sessions Judge, Rohtak and Sh. Vivek Singh, the then
Civil Judge (Junior Division), Faridabad now posted as such at Meham.
Report of the District and Sessions Judge, Rohtak has been received
wherein it is stated that the contemnor has tendered unconditional
apology in writing to Sh. Vivek Singh, Civil Judge (Junior Division)-
cum-Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Meham, who was previously posted at
Faridabad in the chamber of District and Sessions Judge, Rohtak. The
apology has been accepted by the above said Judicial Officer.

The contemnor, present in Court, has submitted that he has
got 37 years of practice and has got great regards for the Courts. The

contemnor has been advised not to repeat such conduct. He has ensured in the positive.

Taking into consideration the magnanimity, which is required to be shown by the Courts, we deem it appropriate to accept the apology and file the present contempt petition.

In view of the above circumstances, the rule is discharged against the contemnor.
