During course of judicial proceedings in the Court of Mr.Amit Verma, Civil Judge (Jr. Div.) We have considered the fact that Mr.S.S.Gulia, Advocate appeared before the District and Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar and expressed his unconditional apology in writing to Shri Amit Verma, learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), who is now posted at Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar. A report has been received that the said apology has been accepted.

In view of the above, we opt to adopt the traditional magnanimity approach of the Courts and drop the proceedings initiated on the basis of the reference of Mr.Amit Verma, Civil Judge (Jr. Division).
