Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.11, dated 25.03.2017, under Sections 379-B/323/324/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dorangla, District Gurdaspur.

FIR came to be registered on the complaint of Dr. Sumesh Kumar. Complainant stated that he was running a clinic and on 24.03.2017 at about 12:45 P.M., when he was proceeding on a two wheeler then two assailants in the age group of 20-25 years came on a motorcycle and intercepted him. The assailant, who was pillion rider gave him a kick and on account of which complainant fell on the ground. The same very assailant is then stated to have given a knife blow which hit the complainant on the right side of the abdomen and his mobile phone make HTC was snatched and taken away.

Perusal of the order dated 11.01.2018 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) declining the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner contains observations that the

police has collected CCTV footage and as per which, it is the present petitioner, who was the pillion rider and has been identified by the complainant.

In view of the serious allegations against the petitioner and the gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
