The petitioner is the complainant. On his complaint FIR No.407 dated 04.08.2011, was registered against the respondents under sections 323/325/34 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Karnal. The learned trial Court convicted the respondents under sections 323 and 325 read with section 34 IPC. However, taking into consideration the fact that respondent No.1 was over 70 years of age and that respondent No.2 was the sole bread-winner of his family, neither of them was having any criminal antecedent coupled with the fact that they both underwent protracted trial and to give them chance to reform themselves, the learned trial Court ordered them to be released on probation of good conduct for a period of six months and to pay compensation of Rs.10,000/- to the complainant-petitioner. The appellate Court upheld the said judgment of conviction and order of releasing the respondents on probation. Hence, the instant revision petition by the petitioner-complainant.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to point out any error in the impugned judgments. His only argument is that a grievous injury had been inflicted upon the person of the petitioner and therefore, the respondent should not have been released on probation. This argument is not acceptable as considering the injury grievous in nature, respondents were convicted under section 325 IPC and by a well reasoned order were ordered to be released on probation.

3. No error or illegality of procedure or jurisdiction has been pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioner. Thus, the petition is without any merit and is accordingly dismissed.
