The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.132 dated 29.11.2015 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 451/323/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Balongi, SAS Nagar, on the basis of compromise dated 10.12.2015 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel and now has been resolved. The injuries are on non-vital parts of the body of complainant.

This Court by the order dated 20.02.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kharar has sent his report dated 06.03.2018 wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the

parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

In view of the law laid down in “*Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab*” 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.132 dated 29.11.2015 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 451/323/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Balongi, SAS Nagar, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed.

All the petitioners are liable to pay litigation cost of Rs.2000/- each to State of Punjab. Cost shall be remitted in the Home Department, State of Punjab within a period of 2 months from today.
