This petition has been filed for quashing of order dated 08.12.2017 (Annexure P-3), whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person in FIR No.193, dated 09.07.2010, under Sections 323, 506, 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District S.A.S. Nagar (Annexure P-1) .

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let two copies of the paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Mr. Ram Pal Verma, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2.

4. The parties are *ad idem* that compromise in respect of above FIR has been effected between them.

5. Since the offences are compoundable under Section 320(1) Cr. P.C., the petition is disposed of with the direction to the parties to appear before the

learned trial Court and move an application for compounding of offences mentioned in the FIR, which shall be dealt with by the learned trial Court according to law.

6. In case petitioner appears/surrenders before the learned trial Court/Area Magistrate, as directed above within 15 days from today, he shall be released on bail by the latter to its satisfaction.
