The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.1 has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 – State and Mr. Sarvesh Kumar Gupta, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.6 and 7.

The matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre where the statement of petitioner No.1 has been recorded, in which, she has stated that she has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 out of her own free will. Counsel for the respondents No.6 and 7 has also signed about the statement of the parties.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that despite the fact that petitioner No.1 has made a statement that she is legally wedded wife of petitioner No.2, the private respondents along with other persons are present in the Court premises and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their lives and liberty.

Heard.

Without examining the question of validity or otherwise of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar to decide the representation dated 16.12.2018 (Annexure P-6).

HC Savan Singh, Police Station Chhiata, Amritsar City, who is present in Court, is directed to take the petitioners from the Court premises to Amritsar.
