The present petition has been filed seeking protection of life and liberty as the petitioners fear that respondents No.4 and 5 (parents and other relations of petitioner No.1) will cause them bodily harm as their marriage has been performed against their wishes.

Petitioners No.1 and 2 are major and the same is proved by their Adhaar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2).

Be that as it may and without commenting upon the validity of the marriage between petitioners No.1 and 2, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No. 2 to ensure that life and liberty of the petitioners be protected by providing them adequate protection after carrying out a threat assessment and as and when deemed appropriate. The representation (Annexure P-5) already made as well as the facts mentioned in this petition shall be kept in mind by him.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
