Since the matter has been compromised between the parties, this fact is admitted by learned counsel appearing for the complainant.

Under the circumstances, the petitioner who is father-in-law of the complainant is granted pre-arrest bail, directing that in case of his arrest, he be released on bail, subject to furnishing personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) he shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer.
- (ii) he shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing.
- (iii) he shall not give any threat or intimidation to the prosecution witnesses.
- (iv) he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if he has got one otherwise to furnish affidavit in that regard.

In addition to that the trial Court may impose any term and condition found suitable to ensure that the petitioner does not abscond and interfere in the trial.

In case the petitioner violates any term and condition on which the bail has been granted to him, the order shall be liable to be withdrawn.
