Petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to comply with the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C in order to secure presence of the petitioner in a lawful manner.

Petitioner has pleaded some incriminating facts against the police in the context of securing some signed blank papers in connivance with the private respondents. The said grievance appears to have been ventilated before Senior Superintendent of Police/respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 06.02.2018. Learned counsel submits that no action has been taken by respondent No.2 till date.
