None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

The present petition pertains to quashing of FIR no.48 dated 21.04.2016, under Sections 279, 427 & 304-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Banur, District Mohali.

Perusal of the earlier orders show that the petitioner had sought time to distinguish a judgment of a Division Bench of this Court reported as 2016(3) Law Herald 2020, Baldev Singh vs. State of Punjab but somehow he has chosen not to appear today.

In fact vide order dated 26.04.2018, it had specifically been recorded that in case the petition is not argued on the next date of hearing an

inference would be taken that “*the petitioner is no longer interested in pursuing the petition or is unable to distinguish the judgment of Division Bench*”.

Despite the matter having been called, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. I do not find any ground to differ with the ratio of judgment in Baldev Singh's case (supra). The petition, as such, is dismissed.
