AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-Ranbir Singh @ Rana has approached this Court for grant of pre-arrest bail after being summoned by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Moga, by order dated 19.12.2017 (Annexure P-3) on an application moved under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is said to have been present on the spot and had pushed complainant-Amarjeet Kaur and, therefore, on the statement of the complainant, petitioner has been summoned. Counsel contends that co-accused of the petitioner namely Kulwinder Singh son of Lakhwinder Singh, Jagjit Singh @ Jaggu son of Ranjit Singh and Jagjit Singh @ Bittu son of Kulwant Singh, have been granted the benefit, as has been prayed, by order dated 16.02.2018 (Annexure P-5) by this Court in *CRM-M No.6469 of 2018* titled as *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab*. He, therefore, prays for similar benefit.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kuldeep Singh, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Counsel for the petitioner has supplied a copy of the petition to the counsel for the State in Court.

Mr. Sant Pal Singh Sidhu, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been summoned by order dated 19.12.2017 on an application moved under Section 319 Cr.P.C. by the prosecution as also the allegations against the petitioner, the present petition is allowed.

Let the petitioner appear before the learned trial Court on 06.03.2018 and move an application for grant of regular bail.

If such an application is made, the same shall be accepted by the trial Court and the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the said Court.
