The present petition has been filed seeking directions to respondent No. 1 to get a fair and impartial enquiry conducted on the complaint dated 12.02.2018 (Annexure P-2).

The allegation in the complaint is that respondents No. 3 to 6 have duped the petitioner and have obtained his thumb impression on a document which is allegedly an agreement to sell his property whereas the petitioner has never agreed to sell his property and no amount has ever been received by him as earnest money.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amandeep S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 and 2. Let three copies of petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity to issue notice to private respondents No. 3 to 6 at this stage.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with directions to Senior Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat

Singh Nagar to conduct an enquiry into the allegations made in the complaint dated

12.02.2018 (Annexure P-2) and associate the petitioner and the private respondents therewith. In case the commission of any cognizable offence is made out upon the complaint and the enquiry, appropriate action be initiated in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
