In the light of the fact that the petitioner had jumped the bail and did not appear before the Court and ultimately was declared a proclaimed offender and was arrested, prayer made in the present petition for grant of regular bail cannot be accepted.

The petition, therefore, stands dismissed.

However, the trial of the petitioner in case FIR No.164, dated 06.07.2011, under Sections 392, 395 IPC at Police Station Division No.5 Civil Lines, District Ludhiana, is ordered to be expedited keeping in view the fact that out of the 10 prosecution witnesses, 8 have already been examined and the next date of hearing is 01.02.2018.
