The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.12 dated 14.1.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307, 452, 336, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was registered on the statement of injured Harpal Singh alias Mintu son of Jiwan Singh wherein it has been stated that Smt. Mandeep Kaur petitioner was standing on the roof of her house and she raised a *Lalkara*. No injury has

been attributed to her. However, supplementary statement of Harpal Singh was recorded on 15.1.2018 wherein he has stated that petitioner Mandeep Kaur has given brick blow while standing on the roof which landed on the head. However, as per MLR, injury No.1 on the head is found to be lacerated wound and simple in nature.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 21.2.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make herself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against her so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
