The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.68 dated 2.10.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 18-C, 27-B(2) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act and Section 21 of Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station GRP, Chandigarh, District GRP, Ambala Cantt.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that recovery in this case has been effected from one Naman Khanna son of Vinod Khanna. As per his disclosure statement (Annexure P-2), he purchased the intoxicating manufactured drugs from a person named Khan of Chhutmalpur near Saharanpur. The name of the petitioner is not mentioned in the disclosure

statement.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Raj Kumar states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing has to be recovered from him.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 21.2.2018 is made absolute till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
