The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.56 dated 05.08.2016, under Sections 498-A, 304-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the orders passed by this court on 21.02.2018, the petitioner has appeared/surrendered before the trial court and furnished the requisite bail bonds, which fact is not disputed by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State.
