The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.30 dated 06.01.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379-B/34 of Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana.

Heard.

It has been submitted that ₹ 500/- was recovered from the present petitioner. However, there is no identification of recovery of money. He is in custody since 07.01.2018.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Ram Saroop son of Sh. Kanshi Ram, is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial

Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned subject to following terms:-

(a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.

(b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.

(c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
